How to deliver your artwork

Delivery of entries for the 2023 Moreton Bay Region Youth Art Awards is available on Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 October.

Things to note:

- Artworks drop off is from 12pm - 6pm on both days.
- The venue is the Strathpine Community Centre at 199 Gympie Road Strathpine.
- Entry is via Mecklem Street where there is parking available. We will be at the end of the cream-coloured community centre through the glass doors.
- A staff member will greet you and mark your work as received. We will then ask you to place your artwork on the table provided and exit the venue.
- We can only accept work that is correctly labelled.
- We are not responsible for the safety of the artworks e.g. wires attached to bits holding the frames together.

How to prepare your artwork

- Artworks must be ready to hang with 'D-rings'. Please attach 'D-rings' (many styles available) which are screwed on each side of the frame or canvas 8cm from the top of the work as shown. We do not accept artwork in plastic or metal frames.
- We also need each work to be labelled. Please complete, print and attach the artwork label provided or add the required details to the back of the artwork yourself.

Important dates

- Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 October – Delivery of artworks from 12pm - 6pm
- Exhibition open from Saturday 14 October - Sunday 22 October, 3pm - 6pm on weekdays and 10am - 4pm on weekends
- Saturday 21 October – Award ceremony from 2pm
- Collection of artworks – Monday 23 October from 12pm - 6pm
