

Moreton Bay Region Youth Art Awards

Conditions of entry for school collaborative awards

Applications are only open to schools based within the Moreton Bay Region.

Entry

1. Entry to the Moreton Bay Region Youth Art Awards is free.
2. Only primary and secondary schools in the Moreton Bay Region may enter - art schools and associated institutions are excluded.
3. Online entries close: 1 September 2021
4. A collaborative team must include three or more students in the same grade group.
5. Each grade group may submit an entry in each category (2D and/or 3D).

Artwork

6. Artwork submitted to the competition must be delivered to the Strathpine Community Centre. 199 Gympie Road, Strathpine between **12noon and 6pm on Wednesday, 6 and Thursday, 7 October 2021.**
Late deliveries will not be accepted.
7. Artwork submitted to the competition must be made by students only, without assistance.
8. Submitted artwork must have the title, group's grade level and the school's name, address, phone number and email address clearly marked on the back (or underneath if 3D artwork).
9. 2D artwork must be framed and ready to hang/display with secure hanging fixtures ("D" rings or wire) on the back.
10. 2D artwork consisting of two (2) parts or more must be securely fixed together and must be ready to hang as outlined in #9 above.
11. 2D artwork must not exceed 2 metres X 2 metres in size – there are no exceptions.
12. 3D artwork must not exceed 2 metres X 2 metres X 2 metres in size, and pieces must not exceed 17kg in weight – there are no exceptions.

Judging

13. All forms of visual art (e.g.: painting, etching, drawing, sculpture, etc.) are eligible to win a prize.
14. Collaborative entries will be judged within grade groups regardless of category.
15. All artwork will be viewed by the judge.
16. Judging will take place at the Strathpine Community Centre by an independent judge who resides outside the Moreton Bay Region.
17. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entertained.

Legal

18. Winning schools from the previous year must use the scholarship money before close of entry for the 2021 Moreton Bay Region Youth Art Awards. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of the award and/or ineligibility for the 2021 Youth Art Awards.
19. Winning schools are expected to document work produced as a result of the scholarship award (workshop, residency, etc.) and submit a report of the scholarship, with images suitable to post on the Moreton Bay Regional Council website. Report and images should be submitted to the Pine Rivers Art Gallery before close of entry for the 2021 Moreton Bay Region Youth Art Awards.
20. Collaborative entries are not eligible for the People's Choice Award.
21. Entry of artwork to the competition constitutes the artist's permission for competition organisers to reproduce the work without fee for the purposes of promotion, in print and electronic media.
22. No responsibility will be taken by competition organisers for damage or breakages of artwork. Every care will be taken by competition organisers to minimise risk of damage.

Collection

23. All artwork must be collected from the Strathpine Community Centre between **12noon and 6pm on Monday, 25 October 2021.**

Note: *Due to storage limitations all artwork not collected on 27 October 2020 will be disposed of at the organiser's discretion.*
