

Pine Rivers Art Gallery – Youth Art Awards

Conditions of entry for Individual awards

Entry

1. Entry to the Moreton Bay Region Youth Art Awards is free.
2. All entrants must live or attend school in the Moreton Bay Region and be aged 18 years or under, as of 31 December 2022.
3. Online entries close: 1 September 2022
4. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
5. The competition organisers reserve the right to reclassify entries where necessary.

Artwork

6. Artwork submitted to the competition must be made only by the entrant without assistance.
7. Artwork submitted to the competition must be delivered to the Strathpine Community Centre between **12noon and 6pm on Wednesday 5 and Thursday 6 October 2022.**
Late deliveries will not be accepted.
8. Submitted artwork must have the title, the entrant's name, address, private phone number, grade level, email address and school clearly marked on the back (or underneath if 3D artwork).
9. 2D artwork must be ready to hang.
 - a) Framed artwork must have "D" rings, or a wire securely fixed to the back of the frame at 8cms from the top of the frame.
 - b) Unframed artwork must be mounted on matt board and have large Velcro tabs securely fixed to the back of the work.
 - c) We reserve the right to add extra fitting to the work or exclude it from the exhibition.
10. 2D artwork consisting of two (2) parts or more must be securely fixed together and must be ready to hang as outlined in #9 above.
11. 2D artwork must not exceed 2 metres X 2 metres in size – there are no exceptions.
12. 3D artwork must not exceed 17kg in weight – there are no exceptions and must be free standing and/or fitted with wall hanging fixtures.

Judging

13. All forms of visual art (e.g. painting, etching, drawing, sculpture, etc.) are eligible to win a prize.
14. All artwork will be viewed by the judge.
15. Judging will take place at the Strathpine Community Centre by an independent judge who resides outside the Moreton Bay Region.
16. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entertained.

Legal

17. Entry of artwork to the competition constitutes the artist's permission for competition organisers to reproduce the work without fee for the purposes of promotion, in print and electronic media.
18. No responsibility will be taken by competition organisers for damage or breakages of artwork. Every care will be taken by competition organisers to minimise risk of damage.

Collection

19. All artwork must be collected from the Strathpine Community Centre between **12noon and 6pm on Monday, 24 October 2022.**

Note: *Due to storage limitations all artwork not collected on 24 October will be disposed of at the organiser's discretion.*
