

Monster paint with paper

Tear up paper to create a colourful monster without using paint!



Materials list

Coloured paper or old magazines

Scissors

White paper or card



Instructions

1. Decide what kind of monster you want to make - scary or friendly? For calm monsters you may choose to use greens and blues. For fiery monsters you might want to use reds or oranges.
2. Tear out some monster bodies and limbs and don't forget to create features like eyes, horns and teeth.
3. Lay them onto the white paper or card and arrange the pieces until you are happy with your design.
4. Glue the pieces into position.
5. Invent a name and personality for your monster. You may even wish to write a story about them!
