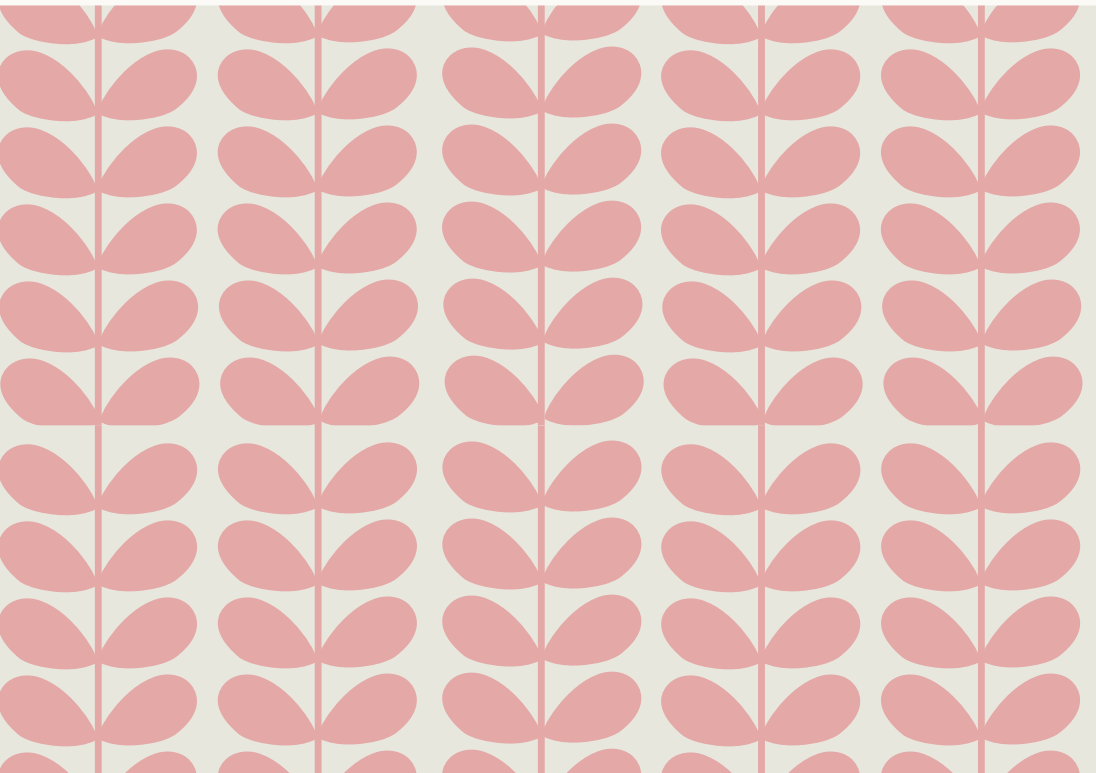

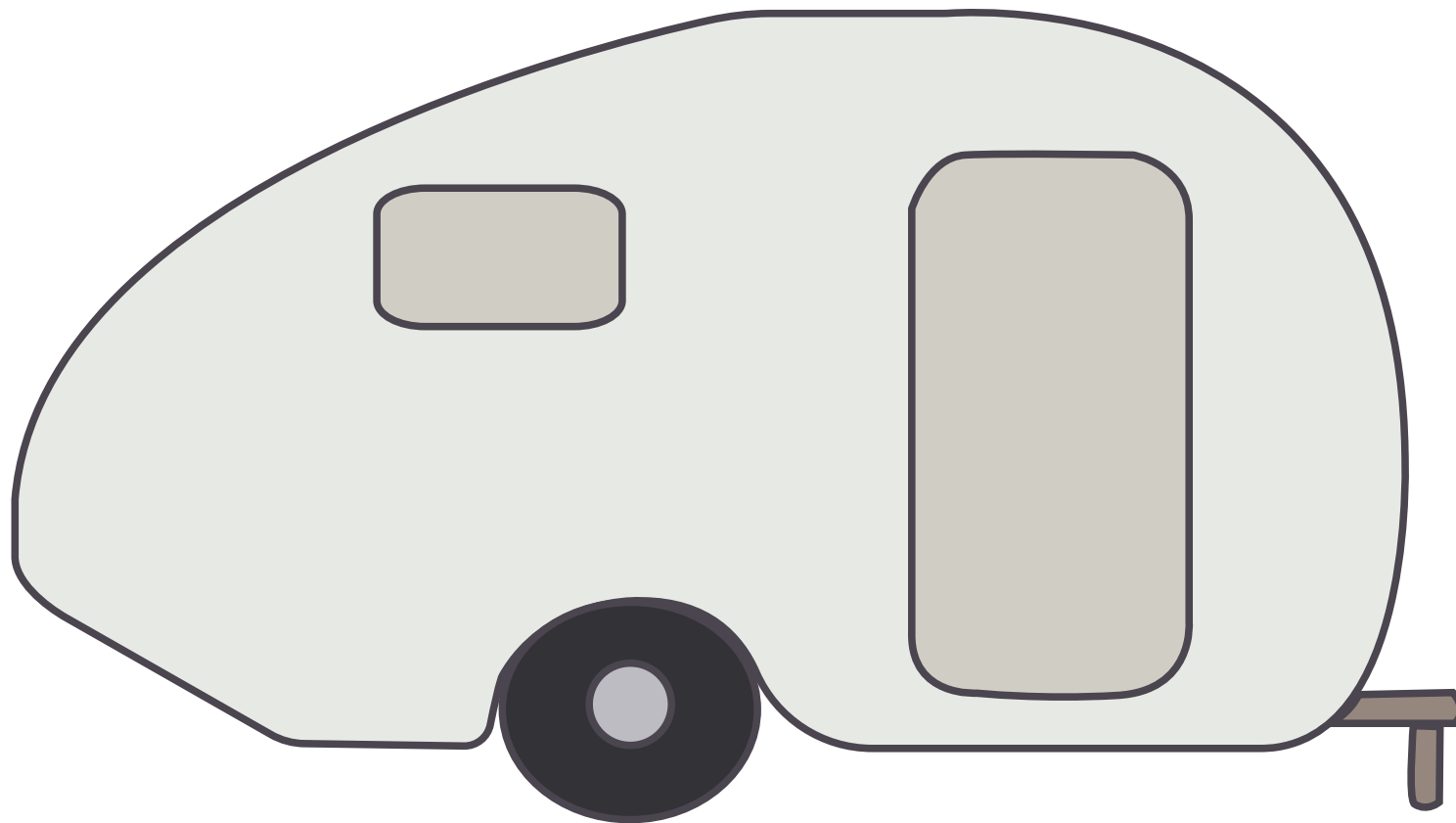
# Activity

5. When you have finished collaging, use texters to add finer details.



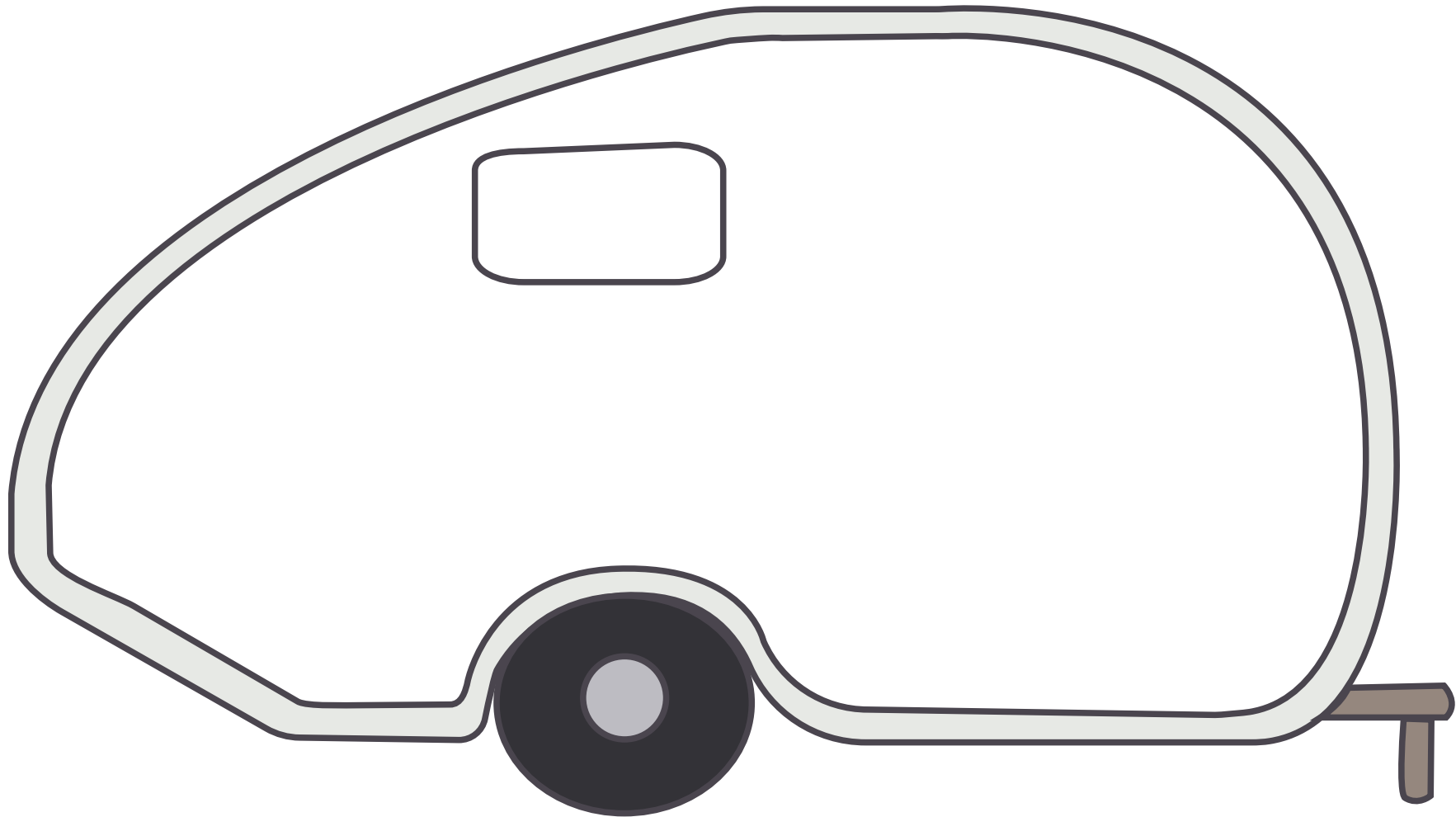

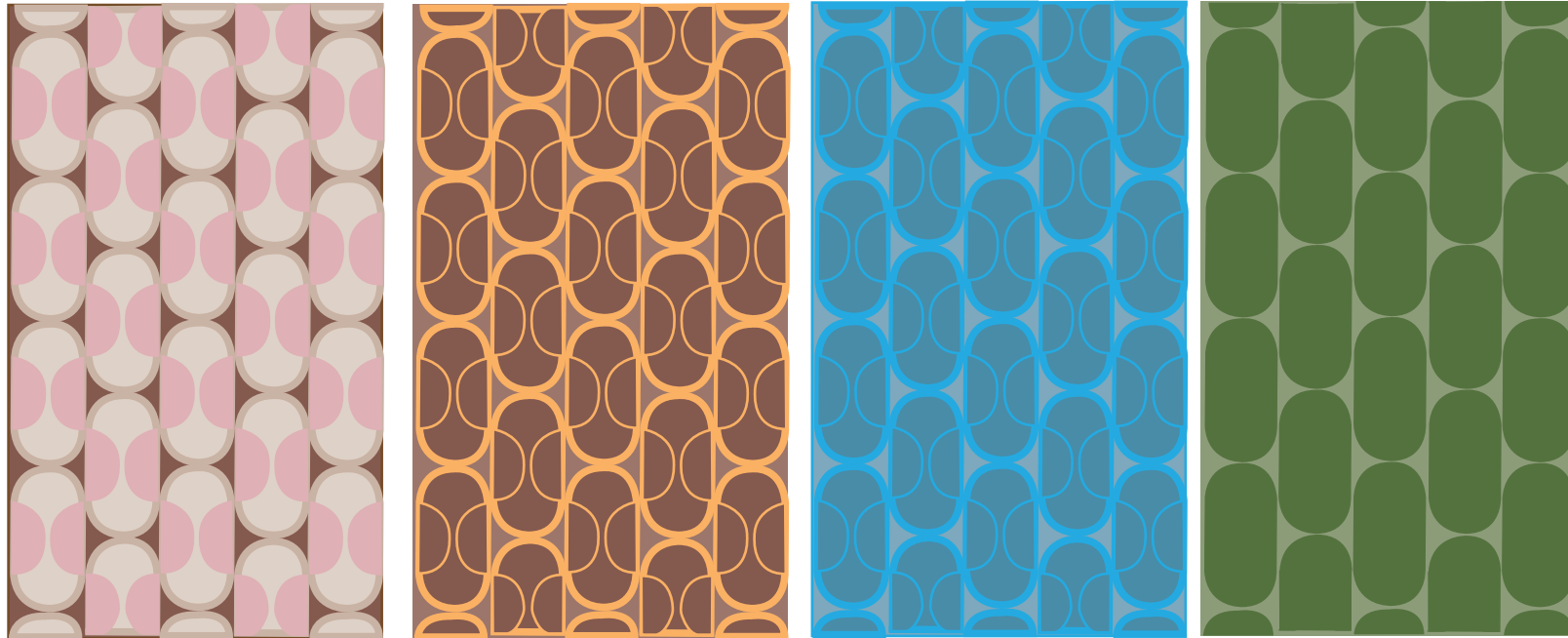
If you can, try printing this activity in A3 so that objects are easier to cut around and paste.

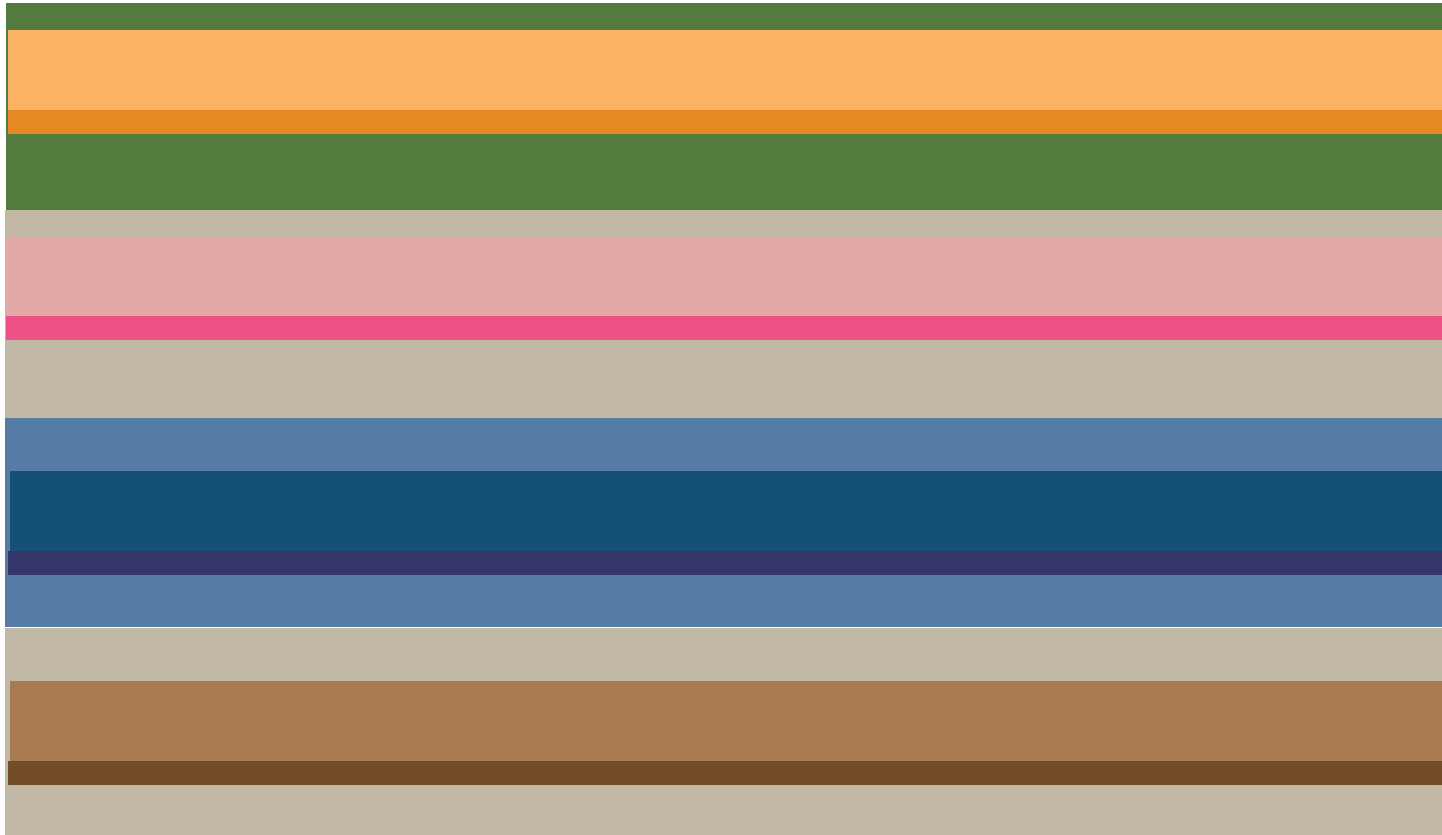
## *Tip:*
