



How it works...

A Book Club is formed, usually with 8-10 people, meeting regularly to discuss a pre-determined book in a friendly, informal setting.

- Library membership card is issued to the Book Club Coordinator in the Book Club name.
- Moreton Bay Region Libraries have available for loan Book Club Sets containing 10 copies of selected titles
- It is recommended that the Book Club designate a regular member to take responsibility for the collection of Book Club Sets.
- Book Clubs may suggest titles to purchase at any time online.
- Book Clubs may meet at any venue.
- Meeting rooms are available for booking at most libraries.
- Book Clubs may meet with any frequency, but it is recommended they meet monthly.

Roles & Responsibilities

Book Clubs

- Apply for Book Club membership of Moreton Bay Region Libraries
- Check the availability of, reserve and collect Book Club Sets for your meetings.
- Return the complete Book Club Set in good condition, by the agreed due date. Partial Sets will not be accepted for return.
- Abide by the membership rules of the Moreton Bay Region Libraries.

Moreton Bay Region Libraries

- Provide online resources for Book Clubs, including suggested procedures for running a Book Club, suggested forms and links to online information.
- Make available for loan to Book Clubs Sets containing 10 copies of selected titles for a period of 6 weeks.
- Permit use of Library meeting rooms for Book Club meetings, with prior arrangement and according to availability.
- Consider for purchase, titles suggested by Book Clubs that are members of Moreton Bay Region Libraries, in line with Collection Development.
- Assist in the promotion and establishment of new clubs, through the provision of information and advice.

Book Club Members

- Commit to attend Book Club meetings.
- Listen to others in the group and respect the opinions of others.
- Participate in the group discussion. Return books to the Book Club Coordinator in good condition by the agreed date.
- Any additional responsibilities, as defined by the individual Book Club.
