





Detail of pool backwash connection in sewered areas

- 1. Pool backwash is to discharge to sewer via an Overflow Relief Gully (ORG).
- 2. If it is not practical to use an existing ORG an alternate one may be installed on the house drain with a hose tap positioned above it.
- 3. When it is necessary to empty the pool, it must be discharged to sewer as per this detail.
- 4. Drainage of the overflow e.g. rainwater, is to discharge to the roof water system.
- 5. An acceptable alternative to the methods shown on this page is to use a temporary flexible connection to the ORG. To prevent sewerage entering the filtration unit this type of connection must be reinstated immediately the backwash session is completed.
