# Call for Proposals

#### Presentation types

15 Minute "Story Circles" - a curated/facilitated space for community members and practitioners to share a project story.

1.5 hour Practice Workshops – an opportunity to share methods and/or outcomes of completed or on-going work. Workshops should be participatory and allow for an exchange of input and learning among participants.

"Critical Conversations" – is there a burning issue that needs a good facilitated dialogue session?

Creative Capers in the "Cellar" - an atmospheric space that lends itself to the arts: slam-poetry, singing, performance and community development!
