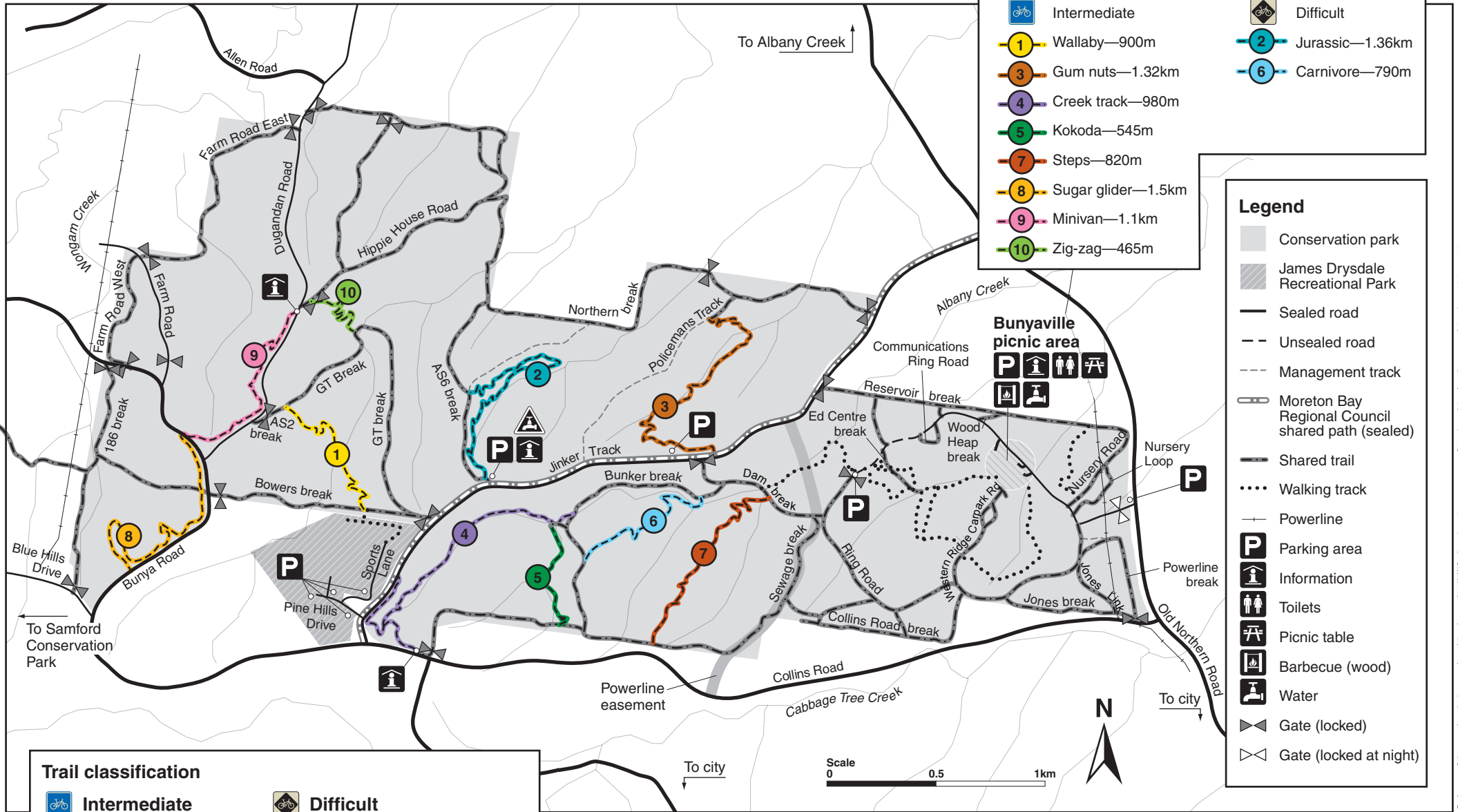


Bunyaville Conservation Park map
