

Weddings and similar services in parks

There are several locations identified within the Region as being particularly suited to Weddings and similar services. These areas range from foreshores to parklands and idyllic bush settings. Details of these areas are listed on the Moreton Bay Regional Council's (MBRC) website. If you are wanting to hold your ceremony at an alternate site to those identified, please contact Council.

Information regarding bookable areas:

- Special **mowing** or additional servicing of the area is not provided. Council maintains its parks and gardens on a routine maintenance schedule.
- To ensure safety of the general public and to avoid potential damage to the park surfaces, no vehicles are to drive or park on grassed areas. All vehicles onsite must be parked lawfully.
- **Electricity** access is not provided. The booking is for the use of the approved area only.
- For environmental purposes the throwing of **confetti, rice** and any other similar material is not permitted. Rose petals and bubbles are permitted.
- A portable **PA** system can be used, however consideration must be given to the volume and the type of music played.
- The insertion of stakes or pegs into the park surface is not permitted. Stand up umbrellas, wedding arches and chairs are permitted, and a "red carpet" may be laid down. All temporary structures must be self-supporting and weighted down.
- **Alcohol** is not permitted to be consumed in public parks in accordance with Queensland State Law.
- **Fireworks** is not permitted.
- **Pathways and walkways must not be obstructed** to ensure the safe passage of the general public during the ceremony or service.
- The park must be left in a **clean and tidy** condition and any **waste** taken off site at the conclusion of your ceremony.

To book the area:

- It should be noted that parks are public places and a permit will not grant exclusive use of the park. However, obtaining a permit will ensure no other approvals will be issued at the specified location, date and time.
- Application can be made **online** by selecting your preferred bookable area and then following the prompts. Please contact the Public Space Permits Team on 07 5433 2637 if the area you are wanting to book is not available online.
- A **non-refundable** processing fee will apply and is payable at time of booking.
- Bookings can only be made for a **maximum of 3 hours** and may be **accepted 12 months in advance**.
- Evidence of a current **Public Liability Insurance** indemnifying Moreton Bay Regional Council for an amount of \$20,000,000 together with an indemnity in Moreton Bay Regional Council's favour executed by the applicant.
- Bookings should be submitted at least 4 weeks prior to the ceremony.

A Local Law Approval may be sent after your request is assessed and a decision is determined.
