



YOUNGS CROSSING UPGRADE

INVESTIGATION WORK

FEBRUARY 2021

Moreton Bay Regional Council is working to upgrade Youngs Crossing Road at Joyner. Based on community feedback and technical considerations, Council is proceeding with the upgrade option that largely follows the existing Youngs Crossing Road alignment.

The project has now moved into the detailed design phase. To inform this phase, survey and various investigations will be carried out intermittently in the area from **mid-February 2021 for approximately six months**.

What's involved?

Investigation work will involve:

- ✓ Scanning, surveying and monitoring roadways, footpaths and open spaces
- ✓ Testing road pavement and ground conditions by drilling and cutting small diameter holes to collect soil and rock samples
- ✓ Environmental inspections and monitoring
- ✓ Identifying utility services using a high-pressure vacuum excavation truck
- ✓ Setting up safe work areas and traffic management.

This work will mostly be undertaken on roads, parks and on Council owned property. If access to private property is required, property owners will be contacted in advance.

All work areas will be restored to their previous condition after investigation work is completed.

Work hours

Work will generally occur between **7:00am and 6:00pm from Monday to Saturday**. Some night work may be required to minimise impacts to traffic.

Temporary traffic changes

To safely carry out this work, some temporary changes will be required including reduced speed limit, stop/go arrangements and lane closures. Traffic control will be in place to assist road users through any changes. Property access will be maintained during the work.
