Conditions:

All applications for tipping authorities must be made in writing by the resident or organisation eligible for a Waste Disposal Authority as detailed in Council's *Policy: 2150-042 - Disposal of Waste Free of Charge at Moreton Bay Regional Council's Waste Management Facilities for eligible Residents, Ratepayers, Community Groups and Charities*

- All applications will be assessed and may be declined at Council's discretion. Applications will be assessed within 10 business days of being received by Council.
- Tipping Authorities are not available for disposing of commercial/business waste, regulated/hazardous waste or where the waste is collected and transported on behalf of a resident for fee and reward (i.e. the person or organisation engaged to deliver the waste on behalf of a resident charges or receives a reward for the service).
- If the waste transporter is not able to present suitable ID matching the details listed on a tipping authority, the waste disposal will be charged in accordance with Council's fees and charges.
- Domestic waste is defined as solid waste comprising of garbage and rubbish such as; clothing, food packaging, food scraps, newspapers/magazines and yard trimmings generated by a household in the Moreton Bay region.

Waste Levy

Council responsibility

From 1 July 2019, landfill operators, including Moreton Bay Regional Council, must collect a waste levy for all waste disposed to landfill on behalf of the Queensland State Government. All waste disposed to landfills attracts the waste levy unless specifically exempt. The purpose of the Waste Levy is to minimise waste being sent to landfills and divert recoverable items for reuse, reprocessing into new products and recycling.

Landfill customer, including residents, responsibility

Landfill customers must provide to the landfill operator all information necessary for the accurate collection and reporting of the waste levy. Providing incorrect or failing to provide information or evading payment of the waste levy is a serious offence and carries heavy penalties. *Waste Reduction and Recycling (Waste Levy) Amendment Act 2019 - Part 53 (Waste Reduction and Recycling Act 2011 from 1 July 2019)* extract:

53 Person delivering waste to waste disposal site to give information

(1) This section applies if a person delivers waste to a waste disposal site.

(2) The person must give the operator of the waste disposal site the information (the delivery information) that the operator reasonably requires to identify—

(a) how much of the waste is exempt waste and how much of it is levyable waste; and

(b) for each type of waste required to be measured by the operator under section 59—how much waste there is; and

(c) whether the waste was generated in the waste levy zone, the non-levy zone or outside Queensland.

Maximum penalty—300 penalty units (\$40,035 from 1 July 2019)
