Through physical theatre and multilingual storytelling, **Identity** dives into the heart of what it means to belong. **Couples Therapy** is a light-hearted show about the ups and downs of marriage. Through poetry, music and projection, **Crossroads: my stories of Balibo** takes you on a family's journey after the murder of a beloved brother and son.

We've got a fantastic range of musical storytelling. **The Garage Band** transports us to an alternate universe where The Beatles never made it big. In **Painting Melody** contemporary visual art melts into song. **Confessions of a Funeral Singer** offers a humorous and tender musical journey through a funeral singer's catalogue.

There's plenty for the whole family to enjoy with three kid-friendly shows programmed back-to-back. Start the morning with **The Amazing Bubble Show** and follow up with **Jaws: For Kids!** where the blockbuster movie about a deadly shark is hilariously reinterpreted. Then enjoy **Too Twisted** with dancers and reality-bending contortionists. Finish the festival on a high with **Limelight**, the annual showcase of City of Moreton Bay's creative talent.
