Flood viewer

View the possible extent of a flood or storm tide event.

Strathpine State School

Example: Strathpine State School

If there is a lot of rain in a very short time, the road may flood. When the rain stops, the flood waters will recede quickly.	X X X X X X X X X
Each year, there is a 5% possibility of a flood in this area (High likelihood).	
Each year, there is a 1% possibility of a flood in this area (Medium likelihood).	
Each year, there a 0.1% possibility of a flood in this area (Low likelihood).	



Flood depth

The **most** likely flood is a **High likelihood** flood.

High likelihood flood (5% possibility each year)

The table explains how **deep** the flood waters may be at Strathpine State School, if there is a **High likelihood** flood.

Storm Tides

When there is a very severe storm over the ocean, sea levels can become very high. We call these high sea levels **Storm Tides**. The storm tides may flood some roads and properties.

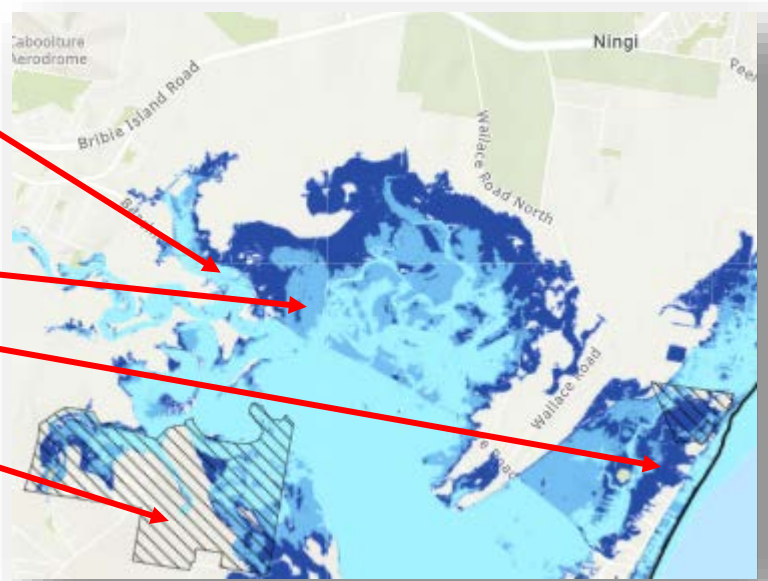
1. On the **Flood viewer**, check how storm tides may affect your property or a local street.

Tap or click → 🔍

2. Then type your address in the box

Example: Bribie Island Road

Each year, there is 5% possibility of a storm tide in this area (High likelihood).	
Each year, there is 1% possibility of a storm tide in this area (Medium likelihood).	
Each year, there is 0.1% possibility of a storm tide in this area (Low likelihood).	
The information may change in this area.	



Storm tide flood depth

The **most** likely storm tide is a **High likelihood** storm tide.

High likelihood storm tide (5% possibility each year)
