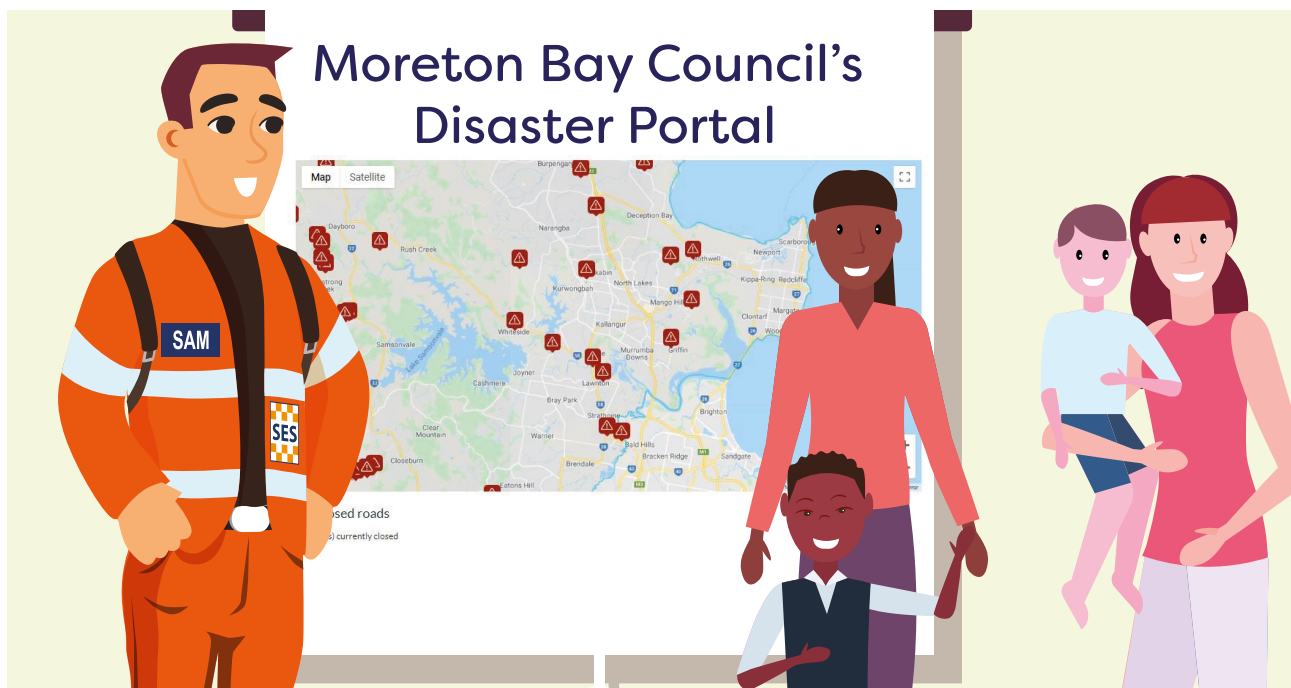

Sam works for the State Emergency Service (SES).
Sam talks about possible disasters.



Sam shows them the Moreton Bay Council's Disaster Portal. The Disaster Portal shows up to date information about natural disasters. It shows closed roads, open sandbag stations and evacuation centres.



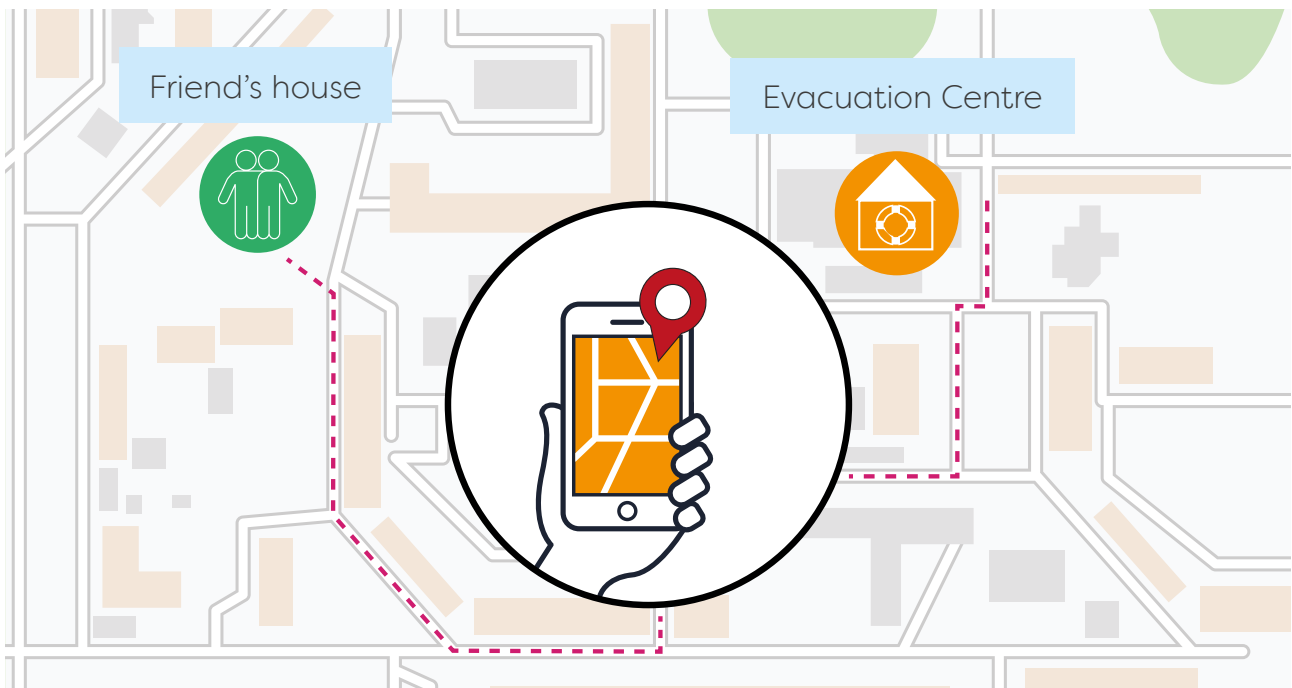
You can ask the SES to help you if your roof is damaged. Download the SES Assistance QLD app.



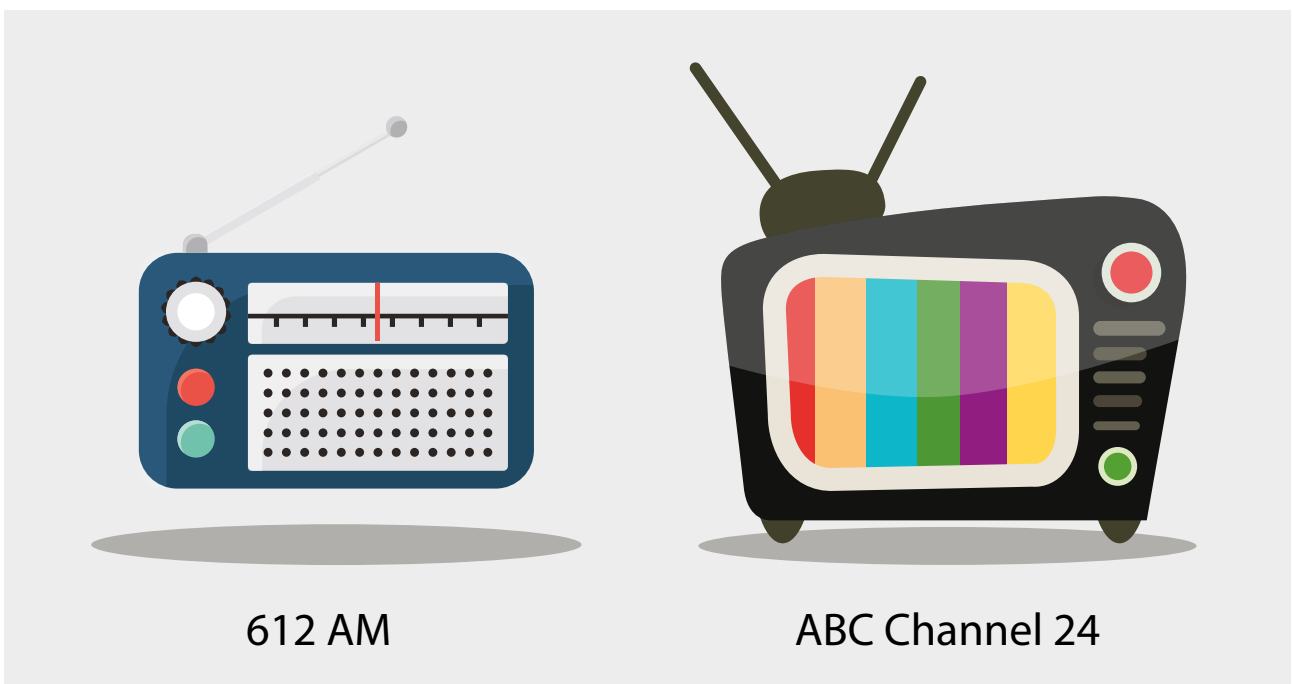
Sam says: "In a natural disaster, it may be dangerous for you to stay at home."



You may need to evacuate. An SES volunteer, fire fighter or police officer will come to your house to tell you to leave.



You must go to a safe place. You can go to a friend's house. If you cannot go to a friend's house, then go to an evacuation centre. Stay at your friend's house or the evacuation centre until your home is safe.



Listen to the radio or watch TV for the latest information. Listen to 612 AM on the radio or watch ABC Channel 24 on TV.



In a natural disaster, your house might be damaged. You may get financial assistance and other support. Call the Community Recovery Hotline to ask for help.
