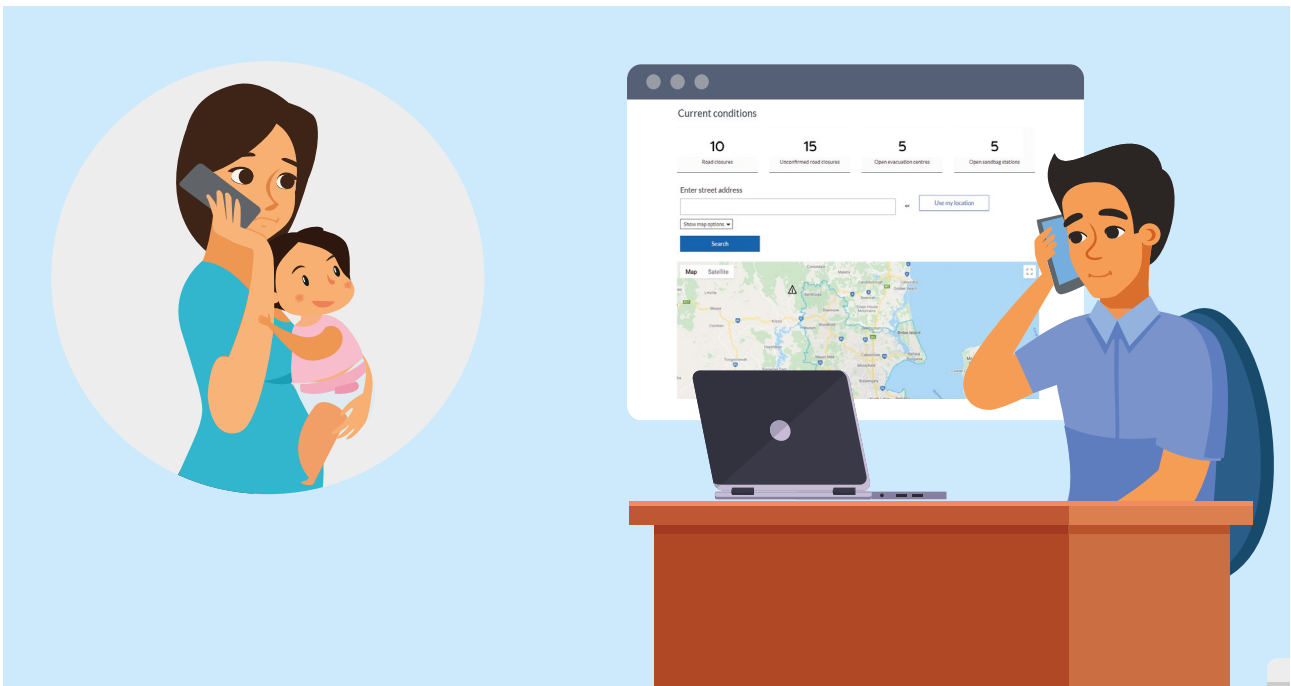

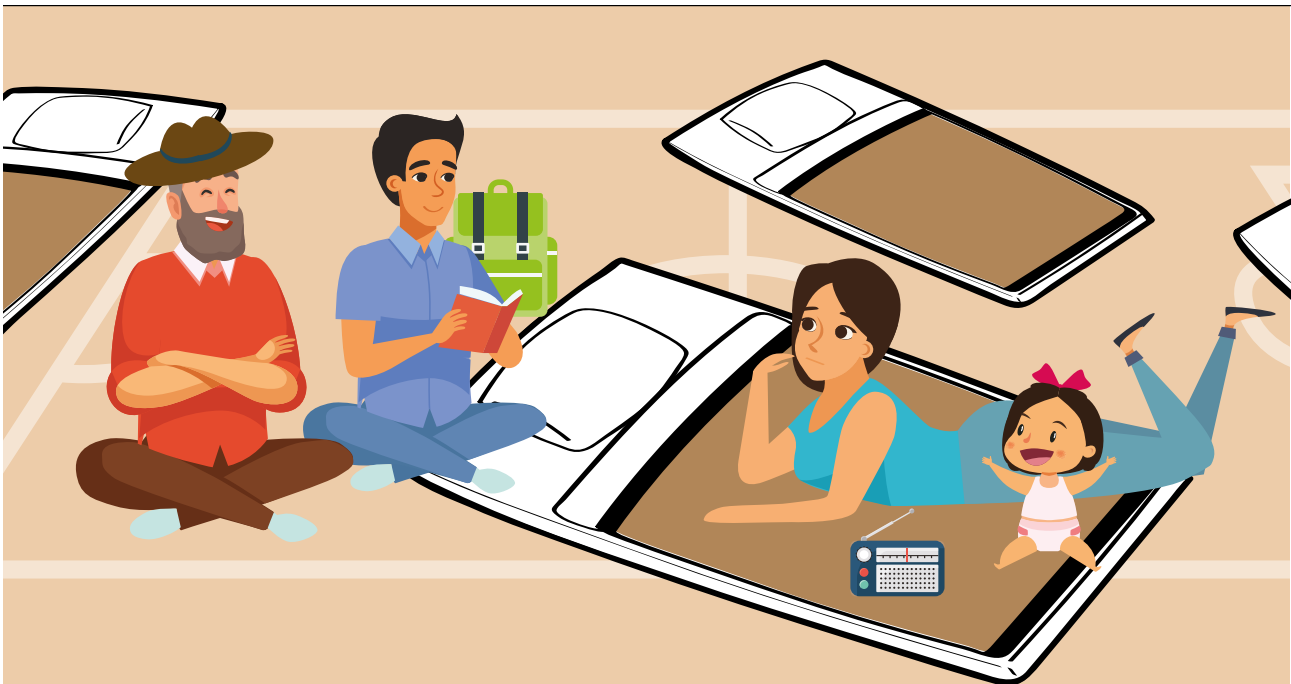
Ali and Lina respond to floods



It is raining heavily. The creek is very high. The police come to Lina's house, "Your house might flood. You must leave before the floodwaters close the road." Lina doesn't have a friend's house to go to. The police officer tells Lina where the closest evacuation centre is.



Lina calls Ali, “We are at an evacuation centre. Can you come here?” Ali checks the Disaster Portal, “If the road is open, I will come to the centre.”



Ali arrives at the evacuation centre and finds Lina and Hana. They see their neighbour Tom. They all sleep at the evacuation centre. Ali, Lina and Tom listen to the radio. Everyone is safe.



In the morning, the evacuation centre manager tells everyone they can go home.



Ali and Lina wear their gumboots and gloves to clean the house.



Floodwaters entered the house. In the living room, the carpets and furniture are very muddy and wet.



Ali and Lina need new carpet and furniture. Lina calls the insurance company and the Community Recovery Hotline. Lina asks the Community Recovery Hotline for some financial help and advice about services that may help them.
