




Ali and Lina stay well in heatwaves




In Australia, summer is very hot. Sometimes the temperature is hotter than usual. If the temperature is hotter than usual for 3 days, it is a **heatwave.**

Hana is too hot. She is very sad and tired. Lina is worried, because Hana may become sick from the heat.






Lina puts Hana in a cool bath. Hana is cooler. Lina checks Hana's temperature. Now, her temperature is normal. She is happy again.




For the rest of the day, Lina and Hana stay in the house. Lina turns on the fan and Hana plays. Lina gives Hana lots of water.


