BEFORE

UNDERSTANDING YOUR RISK

- [Moreton Bay Flood Viewer](#)
Place in resident's address to view the possible extent of a flood or storm tide event
- [QFES Bushfire Postcode Checker](#)
Enter resident's address, postcode or suburb to see bushfire potential to take hold, spread and do damage.

BEING PREPARED

- [Moreton Alert](#)
A free SMS, email and voice message alerting system that provides severe weather warnings, council prescribed burn notifications, bushfire warning messages, potential flash flooding incidents and planned dam releases within the Moreton region. Messages include basic information about the type of emergency, the level of threat and recommended action to take.

Workbook & Toolkit used by people with disability to tailor emergency preparedness to their individual support needs

Form for resident to fill and keep on hand with emergency information, important phone numbers, alternative accommodation, medical plan, current medications, will and insurance information, important items and animal plans.

Links for residents to follow regarding home & property bushfire preparation, whether residents choose to leave early or stay and fight the fire and where to tune into for up to date bushfire warnings.

DURING

- [Disaster Portal](#)
Place address in search box and legend icons will show up if events are occurring in area. The portal provides information on local road closures in Moreton, bushfire events, sandbag stations, evacuation centres, news and alerts, links to Council's social media notifications and links to the most up to date information from Emergency service agencies (eg BOM, QFES)
- [Bureau of Meteorology \(BOM\)](#)
Residents can use different BOM links to view weather and warnings, radar imagery, cyclone tracking maps and forecasts for the Moreton region.

AFTER

- [Health, wellbeing and cleaning up after a storm, flood and cyclone](#)
Includes information on: returning to affected buildings, home and property repairs, restoring pools and water tanks, common bacterial infections, floodwater contamination, plumbing and water use, mould and asbestos
- [Returning home after a bushfire](#)
Provides factsheets to assist residents in preparing for bushfire aftermath including maintaining rainwater quality, smoke effects, airborne dust, alternative fuel resources and asbestos hazards

Finding temporary accommodation, applying for financial assistance, repairing your home, help with rental and social housing

Assistance and Grants available if resident is directly affected by a natural disaster
