

Species List for Regional Ecosystem 12.1.1

Swamp She Oak (Casuarina glauca) forest

Description:	The dominant species in this ecosystem is <i>Casuarina glauca</i> (Swamp She oak). <i>Casuarina glauca</i> ± <i>Melaleuca quinquenervia</i> ± <i>mangroves</i> open-forest. Occurs on margins of Quaternary estuarine deposits.
Ecological values:	Only 2% of the preclearing area remains. Subject to weed invasion, especially groundsel (<i>Baccharis halimifolia</i>). Provides wetland habitat values.
Representative areas in the MBRC:	Antigua Cres Park, Bayside Dr Lake, Beachmere Boat Ramp, Beerburrum East SF, Bullock Ck CP, Dohles Rocks Rd Park, Duffield Rd Park, Elizabeth Rd Res, Hays Inlet CP 1, Macdonnell Rd Cons Res, Morris Park, Ningi Ck CP, Old Beachmere Rd Park (Beachmere), Toorbul Community & Sports Ctr, Turners Camp, Uhlmann Rd

Conservation status- Vegetation Management Act (Qld) 1999- of concern (36.91 % remaining locally)




Figure 1: Representative areas in the MBRC where RE 12.1.1 can be found.
