

Species List for Regional Ecosystem 12.11.14

Narrow-leaf Ironbark (*Eucalyptus crebra*) and Blue Gum (*E. tereticornis*) grassy woodland

Description: *Eucalyptus crebra*, *E. tereticornis* grassy woodland. Other species including *Eucalyptus melanophloia*, *Corymbia clarksoniana*, *C. erythrophloia*, *C. tessellaris*, *Angophora* spp. may be present in low densities or in patches. Mid- layer generally sparse but can include low trees such as *Acacia bidwillii*, *Capparis* spp., *Dodonaea triquetra*, *Alphitonia excelsa* and *Xanthorrhoea* spp. Occurs on mid and lower slopes on Paleozoic and older moderately to strongly deformed and metamorphosed sediments and interbedded volcanics.

Conservation status: *Vegetation Management Act (Qld) 1999* - of concern (14.82 % remaining locally)
