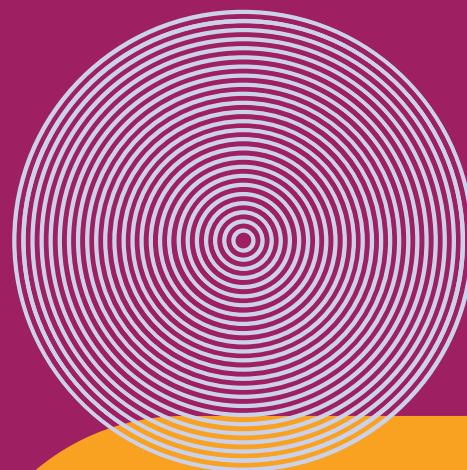

An area of natural beauty, it boasts access to the iconic waters of Moreton Bay, the city's namesake, and the D'Aguiar mountain range. We have extensive waterways, wetlands and bushland corridors with an abundance of wildlife, much of which is of national and international significance.
