Note: In carrying out your activity you must take all reasonable and practicable measures to ensure that it does not harm Aboriginal cultural heritage (the "cultural heritage duty of care"). You will comply with the cultural heritage duty of care if you are acting in accordance with gazetted cultural heritage duty of care guidelines. An assessment of your proposed activity against the duty of care guidelines will help determine whether or to what extent Aboriginal cultural heritage may be harmed by your activity. **Note:** Under certain conditions, all land is potentially subject to landslide risk. Landslide risk mitigation measures should be considered when proposing any building or structure, particularly in rural and rural residential areas. Exemption from assessment against the Landslide Hazard Overlay Code does not infer an absence of landslide risk.
