Division 8 - Assessment Criteria for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay

6.26 Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code

The provisions in this division comprise the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code. They are:

- compliance with the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code (section 6.27);
- overall outcomes for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code (section 6.28);
- specific outcome and probable solution for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code (section 6.29).

6.27 Compliance with the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code

Development that is consistent with the specific outcomes in section 6.29 complies with the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code.

6.28 Overall Outcomes for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code

- (a) The overall outcome is the purpose of the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code.
- (b) The overall outcome sought for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code is the following:
 - (i) good quality agricultural land is protected from development that may alienate it from or conflict with its productive use.

6.29 Specific Outcomes and Probable Solution for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code

The specific outcomes sought for the Good Quality Agricultural Land Overlay Code are included in column 1 of table 6.7. Probable solutions for code assessable development are included in column 2 of table 6.7.
