# Division 12 – Home Based Business

#### 7.42 Home Based Business Code

The provisions in this division comprise the Home Based Business Code. They are:

- Compliance with the Home Based Business Code (section 7.43);
- Overall outcomes of the Home Based Business Code (section 7.44);
- Specific outcomes, acceptable solutions and probable solutions for the Home Based Business Code (section 7.45).

### 7.43 Compliance with the Home Based Business Code

Development that is consistent with the specific outcomes in section 7.45 complies with the Home Based Business Code.

## 7.44 Overall Outcomes of the Home Based Business Code

- (a) The overall outcomes are the purpose of the Home Based Business Code
- (b) The overall outcomes sought for the Home Based Business Code are:
  - (i) home based businesses promote employment creation and growth through providing an affordable location for small scale and start-up businesses; and
  - (ii) home based businesses are domestic in scale and operate in a manner that is ancillary to the related dwelling house and consistent with the stated planning character of the area.

*Note:* The stated planning character is described in the overall outcomes contained within the Planning Area Code.

### 7.45 Specific Outcomes, Acceptable Solutions and Probable Solutions for the Home Based Business Code

The specific outcomes sought for the Home Based Business Code are included in column 1 of table 7.14. Acceptable solutions for self-assessable development and probable solutions for code assessable development are included in column 2 of table 7.14.
