Guidelines:

All memorials:

- Are considered temporary
- Should not exceed dimensions of:
 - o height 750mm
 - o width 400mm
 - o depth 400mm (below ground level)
 - thickness
- Must be painted white non-reflective
- Should be located no closer then:
 - o three (3) from any bitumen/road seal
 - o one (1) metre behind the line of guide posts
 - o one (1) metre from the edge of any shared path
- Shall not be located:
 - where they may interfere with any traffic control item
 - o in close proximity of residential dwellings

Moreton Bay Regional Council commitment:

Council acknowledges that the death of a loved one as a result of a traffic accident can be very traumatic. As such, council's approach to the issue of roadside memorials will be sensitive to the emotions of affected community members.
