# **CHAPTER 5 – OVERLAY CODES**

# PART 13 OPERATIONAL AIRSPACE AND AVIATION FACILITIES OVERLAY CODE

# Division 1 Applicability of the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

## 1.1 This code applies to development:-

- (1) that is located<sup>1</sup> in "operational airspace footprint", "aviation facility buffer area" or "wildlife hazard buffer area" shown on *Overlay Code Map 13 Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities;* and
- (2) referred to as "code assessable" in Tables 5.13.1 or 5.13.2 below.

# Division 2 Assessment Tables for the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

2.1 Assessment Categories for the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

The assessment categories are identified for development in Column 2 of Tables 5.13.1 or 5.13.2, as follows:-

- (1) Table 5.13.1 Material Change of Use and Associated Works<sup>2</sup> for uses listed in Column 1; or
- (2) Table 5.13.2 Other Development not associated with a Material Change of Use<sup>3</sup> listed in Column 1.

Note: Zones also affect assessment categories. See zone maps to determine the zone of the land. Also see Chapter 1, Part 1, Division 4, Section 4.8(3) explaining how the higher assessment category prevails.

### 2.2 Relevant Assessment Criteria for Development Affected by the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

- (1) The relevant assessment criteria in the overlay code are referred to in Column 3 of Tables 5.13.1 and 5.13.2.
- (2) For development requiring code assessment, the relevant assessment criteria are applicable codes.

# Division 3 Compliance with the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

3.1 Assessable development that is consistent with the specific outcomes contained in Division 5, Table 5.13.3 complies with the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code.

# Division 4 Overall Outcomes for the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

- 4.1 The overall outcomes are the purpose of this code.
- 4.2 The overall outcomes sought by the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code are the following:-
  - (1) The safety of aircraft using operational airspace is not compromised by development impacts; and
  - (2) The operation of aviation facilities is not compromised by development impacts.

# Division 5 Specific Outcomes for the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code

5.1 The specific outcomes and probable solutions for the Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities Overlay Code are contained in Table 5.13.3. The elements covered by the specific outcomes are:-

- (1) Siting and Height of Buildings, **Structures** and Other Objects;
- (2) Transient/Intermittent Activities;
- (3) Emission Standards; and
- (4) Wildlife Impacts.

- <sup>3</sup> Table 5.13.2 refers to other development including works not undertaken at the same time as the material change use. Also, see *planning scheme* explanatory notes giving examples that explain the type of development involved in different proposals.

"Operational airspace" has the meaning given in *State Planning Policy 1/02 "Development in the Vicinity of Certain Airports and Aviation Facilities*" and for the purposes of this code, includes that space above the operational airspace footprint shown on *Overlay Code Map 5.13* - Operational Airspace and Aviation Facilities.

"Aviation facilities" has the meaning given in State Planning Policy 1/02 "Development in the Vicinity of Certain Airports and Aviation Facilities".

<sup>8</sup> Exempt building work may still require a building development approval from a building certifier under the Building Act.
