


**Image 56 - Acceptable**. Entries to development expressed as a feature element.

**Image 60 - Unacceptable.** Landscaping in car parks is to provide both shade and definition.





Image 61 - Acceptable. Elevation of retaining wall and bulky goods retail viewed from Bruce Highway.
