

Covid-19 FAQ Sheet - Stage 3 Casual Shoot Around

Commencing Monday 6th July 2020

With the Queensland Government moving to Stage 3 of the Covid-19 Easing Restrictions Roadmap - MSEC are now able to make the following changes to Casual Shoot Around. From Monday 6th July MSEC's casual basketball shoot around procedures will change as follows:

Pre-Bookings are essential

- Bookings must be made over the phone to secure your spot. As per Covid-19 Government tracing requirements, contact details must be submitted as part of your booking requirements.
- MSEC's booking office will be open Monday-Friday 8am-5pm.
- Bookings can be made by phoning (07)5498 6211.

Payment Options

- Sessions are \$5 per person.
- Payment can be made at time of booking over the phone OR onsite when you arrive.
- Contactless payment is preferred via eftpos, not cash.
- Wristbands will be issued to all players. Players are to secure them to their wrists themselves.

Spectators

- Spectators are now permitted but must pre-book and provide contact details as per Covid-19 Government tracing requirements.
- Social distancing requirements are to be adhered to at all times.

Casual Shoot Around Availability

- Session times will now be available for up to 2 hours.
- Set booking times and courts will be allocated to allow for MSEC staff to clean areas after each use.
- Available timeslots will be dependent on venue bookings. Phone to book.

Casual Shoot Around Activity Permissions

- On-court contact is now permitted. This means 1 on 1, 3 on 3 and scrimmage activities will be permitted.
- Standard Conditions of Hire apply to all users in conjunction with Covid-19 conditions and rules.
- Staff instructions are to be followed at all times.

Covid-19 Safety Requirements

- Players will be required to pre-book via phone and will be required to answer Covid-19 safety questions.
- On arrival, players and spectators will be required to sign in at the reception desk.
- Players allocated to play in Stadium 1 will be restricted to access to Stadium 1 toilets only. Players allocated to play in Stadium 2 will be restricted to Stadium 2 toilets only.
- All showers and changerooms will be closed.
- All players will be required to clean up after their session and all rubbish is to be placed in bins provided.
- Each court will have a hand sanitiser station set up for use by players.
- All players will be expected to maintain social distancing & hygiene rules.
- Players are to provide and sanitise their own basketball before use.
- Use of water bubbler will not be permitted. Players are to provide their own water bottle or purchase from café.
- Players should not attend the facility if they are displaying any signs of illness.
- Players to be aware that this situation can, and will be, changed as per Government guidelines and/or any potential or confirmed outbreak at MSEC or someone who has visited MSEC.
- Players will be advised that should they fail to comply with the guidelines, they will not be able to re-book.
- Players are to vacate the premises promptly at the end of their session time to allow staff to conduct any required cleaning.
