

Terms and Conditions of Entry
Moreton Bay Regional Council – Regional Recycler Competition

1. By completing and submitting an entry form to the Regional Recycler competition ('Competition') each entrant agrees to be bound by the following terms and conditions of entry. The promoter of the Competition is Moreton Bay Regional Council ('Council').
2. Council will accept entries to the Competition from 8.00am on Monday 10 July 2017 until midnight on Friday 6 October 2017. Entries received after this time may not be considered. The Council reserves a sole discretionary right to accept, reject or refuse any entry at any time.
3. Entrants must be at their date of entry, residents of Council's local government area. Entrants may be any age. Officers, agents and Councillors of Council (including their direct relations) are ineligible for entry into this Competition. Only one entry to this Competition per group (School or Early learning centre) will be accepted by Council. The Competition is open to schools and early learning centres within the Moreton Bay Region.
4. Instructions on how to enter the Competition and other details (including prize details) contained on Council's website regarding this Competition form part of the conditions of entry. However, the Council is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information.
5. Council may vary the terms and conditions of this Competition at any time at its absolute discretion.
6. Incomplete, illegible or incomprehensible entries (as determined by Council) will be deemed invalid. Council does not accept responsibility for lost, late or misdirected entries.
7. An assessment panel of Council officers including the Mayor and Councillors will judge all entries received against set criteria decided by the panel to determine winners. The entrant scoring highest against these criteria will win the competition and any runners up will be those entrants with the next highest scores.
8. The decisions of the panel will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Winners and runners-up winning prizes will be announced at a Council meeting in the week prior to National Recycling Week (November 2017). Prize details for this Competition can be found on Council's website. Prizes for this Competition are not transferable or exchangeable. Results of this Competition may be published. Council will contact the Winners of each prize to coordinate an appointment for the award presentation and to confirm bank transfer details. Council will not contact entrants who do not win a prize.
10. Entrants to the Competition:
 - (a) agree to freely participate in any reasonable promotional, marketing or publicity purposes of Council;
 - (b) agree that Council may, without notice to the entrant or payment of any fee, use the entry or part thereof for any local government purpose including promotional, marketing or publicity purposes;
 - (c) warrant that they are the owner of all intellectual property rights and moral rights in the entry and consent to Council doing such things to the entry as contemplated by these Terms and Conditions of Entry.
11. A video, photograph or other material entered into this Competition that displays a person or information may infringe on a person's right for privacy, proprietary rights or may disclose personal information, for example. Entrants are required to complete Council photograph approval forms for all entrants, including parental/guardian consent for children and provide in their competition registration. Entrants warrant that they have not infringed any rights of this kind.
12. Entrants' warrant that they are entitled to enter this Competition and, in doing so, will not infringe the rights of a third party.
13. If Council's conduct of the Competition or Council's ability to deliver the prize/s to the prize winner/s of the Competition is hindered in any way, Council may, in its discretion, cancel, postpone, reschedule or otherwise modify the Competition at its discretion.
14. Entries to the Competition will become the property of Council and will not be returned to the entrants.

15. Entrants acknowledge that they voluntarily undertake any risks associated with this Competition (including the installation and use of any prize given to them as a result of this Competition) and waive any right to claim that they may have against Council, including its Councillors, employees, agents and officers which may arise from the entrant's participation in this Competition.
16. Entrants release and indemnify Council, including its Councillors, employees, agents and officers from any and all liability for damage, loss, injury or death howsoever caused which may be suffered as a result of or arising from their entry to this Competition, their breach of these terms and conditions or the installation and use of any prize won as a result of this Competition.
17. Entrants acknowledge and agree that the Council, including its Councillors, employees, agents and officers may plead the above waiver and indemnity as a bar to any proceedings which may be commenced against all or any of them.
18. Any of these terms and conditions which are capable of having effect following the completion, termination, expiration or cancellation of the Competition (including without limitation any waiver or indemnity clause) must remain in full force and effect.
19. These terms and conditions are to be governed by the law in force in the State of Queensland and the entrant submits to the laws and the Courts of that jurisdiction. If any of these terms and conditions are found by a Court to be invalid or unenforceable, that term and condition must be read down to the extent that these terms and conditions can remain in force.
